

How to View Your CE Credits Online

You know you've taken courses offering continuing education credits, but you just can't remember how many? Have you completed the continuing education requirements needed for license renewal? Has the course sponsor reported your earned credits to the state? Don't know where to find the answers to these questions?

Just visit the Florida Department of Business and Professional Regulation (DBPR) website and in minutes you'll have the answers to your questions! How do I access the website? We're glad you asked! Just follow these directions and your wish will be granted!

On the left side of the page under User Services, click on "View Continuing Ed."



If this is your first time accessing DBPR Online Services, click on "Activate Your Online Services Account" and complete the information under "Enter Initial Pin." (Your initial pin number should be the last four digits of your Social Security number or Federal Tax ID number. If neither of those numbers work, call the Customer Contact Center at 850.487.1395 for assistance. The Center is open Monday-Friday, 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. and Saturday, 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. EST.)

Once you have set up your ID and pin number, you are granted access to your online account at any time...and you'll never have to rub a lamp!
